

Conference materials will be published in a collected proceedings volume. In addition, the best papers (abstracts) may be recommended for publication in the scientific electronic journal “Renessans ta’lim xabarlari.”

The paper (abstract) must clearly reflect the author’s original views on the research problem, provide well-defined scientific conclusions, and include practical proposals and recommendations.

Publication costs are covered by the author. The abstract must be at least 5 pages in length.

Requirements for the Structure of the Abstract:

Title

The title should be concise and clearly reflect the research direction.

Author Information

This section must include: Full name of the author (including patronymic), Place of work and position, Academic degree and title (in Uzbek, Russian, and English), Email address, ORCID.

All information must be provided in full, without abbreviations.

A personal contact phone number may also be included (the number will not be shared with third parties).

Abstract

A brief summary (8–10 lines maximum) must be provided in Uzbek, Russian, and English.

Keywords

Keywords in Uzbek, Russian, and English should clearly reflect the content and purpose of the research. It is recommended that each selected keyword appear approximately 5–10 times in the main text.

Conclusion / Recommendations

References

In-text citations must be formatted in square brackets, for example: [1].





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
