7. A copy of the Master's Thesis, Capstone, or a Research sample.
8. Preliminary doctoral dissertation proposal (2000 words).

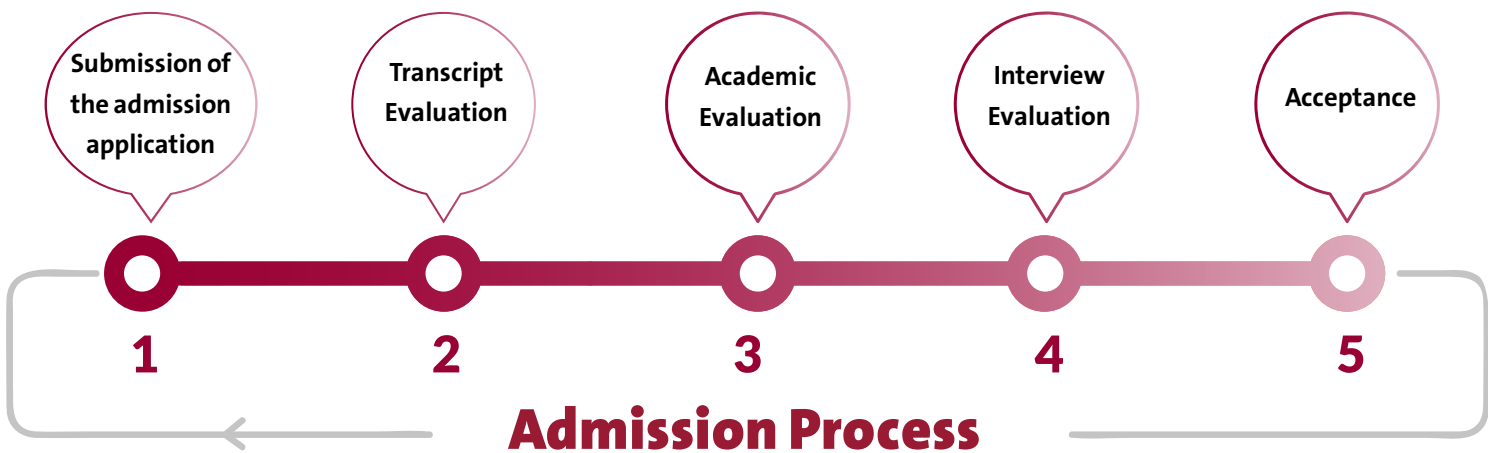

Important Dates



Admission Conditions

- 1 - The applicant must have earned a bachelor's degree (Full time study) or its equivalent with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0. Students in their final BA year are eligible to apply for admission if they obtain their final degree by August 1st of the same year.
- 2 - The applicant must be able to study and do research in Arabic and English. Speakers of languages other than Arabic will be invited to take an Arabic test (oral and written) before admission.
- 3 - The applicant must meet one of the English language requirements:

		
Admission Requirement	59	5.5
Graduation Requirement	79	6.5
or complete the English language courses at the Doha Institute		

* In certain circumstances, students can submit a DELF B2 test result with a minimum score of 50 as an alternative to the IELTS/TOEFL test to meet the admission requirement, noting that the required level of English must be achieved prior to graduation.

* The student is exempted from the English language requirement if he/she has obtained a bachelor's degree from one of the American, British, Canadian, Arab or Australian universities or from their overseas branches, or from Qatari universities that adopt the English language as a
