


# Why Doha Institute For Graduate Studies?

# Academic Programs: PhD

The mission of the Doctoral Studies program is to nurture accomplished scholars and innovative researchers through world-class training in a dynamic and crossdisciplinary intellectual environment. Doctoral students at the DI will master key concepts, methodologies and theories to emerge as well-rounded scholars who are critically aware of the Arab region's pressing issues and are able to engage with them in a globalized context.



#### Admission Conditions

1- The applicant must have earned a bachelor's degree in the field of specialization or a related field, with a GPA of no less than 3.2, and a master's degree or its equivalent with a GPA of no less than 3.5 out of 4.00 (or its equivalent) from an accredited university recognized by the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Qatar, and in a specialization related to the research field to which the candidate is applying. 2- The applicant must prove that his study was

regularly conducted (Full time study) to obtain the bachelor's and master's degrees.

3- The applicant must be able to study and research academically in Arabic with a measure of English language proficiency.

# **Required Documents**

- 1. Proof of undergraduate & graduate education.
- 2. Undergraduate & Graduate transcripts.
- 3. Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- 4. Statement of purpose (750 1000 words).
- 5. IELTS Academic score 6.5 or TOEFL iBT 79. The English language requirement might be waived in the case of candidates who obtained degrees from one of the universities endorsed by DI where English language is the official language of instruction.
- 6. 3 Recommendation Letters.
- 7. A copy of the Master's Thesis, Capstone, or a Research sample.
- 8. Preliminary doctoral dissertation proposal (2000 words ).



## **Admission Conditions**

1 - The applicant must have earned a bachelor's degree (Full time study) or its equivalent with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0. Students in their final BA year are eligible to apply for admission if they obtain their final degree by August 1st of the same year.

2 - The applicant must be able to study and do research in Arabic and English. Speakers of languages other than Arabic will be invited to take an Arabic test (oral and written) before admission.

3 - The applicant must meet one of the English language requirements:

	TOEFL IBT	<b>IELTS</b> ACADEMIC
Admission Requirement	59	5.5
Graduation Requirement	79	6.5
	or complete the English language courses at the Doha Institute	

In certain circumstances, students can submit a DELF B2 test result with a minimum score of 50 as an alternative to the IELTS/TOEFL test to meet the admission requirement, noting that the required level of English must be achieved prior to graduation.

\* The student is exempted from the English language requirement if he/she has obtained a bachelor's degree from one of the American, British, Canadian, Arab or Australian universities or from their overseas branches, or from Qatari universities that adopt the English language as a
