Building on our successful participation at COP29 and looking ahead by drawing on context from COP30, the School of Management at the University of Bradford brings you the 11th iteration of its flagship student learning experience, the International Master's Summer School (IMSS) for Sustainability in Business. Offering a unique opportunity to come together with a range of international students from a diverse set of backgrounds and experiences, IMSS provides an opportunity to explore, develop, and apply sustainability ideas and thinking in the application of circular economy concepts and principles to our world. Running over one-week IMSS will be facilitated and supported by an exciting line-up of academic and industry speakers

Our Summer School welcome's international Master's-level students from around the world to:

- Develop awareness of challenges and opportunities for sustainability, climate change and the circular economy in business globally.
- Challenge understanding of conventional linear business models.
- Be inspired by innovative ideas and thinking from practitioners.
- Contribute to a critical thinking forum on sustainability.
- Engage in team-based sustainability discussion and challenges through individual and shared learning.
- Take part in experiential learning and social-cultural experiences
