The Summer Language Program offers a unique opportunity to explore the languages and cultures of Central Asia in an international academic setting.

Students can take one three-credit course in Kazakh, Chagatay, Russian, Uyghur, or Chinese, with classes taught in an interactive format.

The program also includes workshops, conversation clubs, excursions, and cultural activities, providing an authentic experience of Kazakhstan's history and contemporary life – a true linguistic and cultural immersion in the heart of Eurasia.

COURSES

KAZ1501 Beginning Kazakh (3 credits/5 ECTS)

Instructor: TBA in late 2025

The course emphasizes all four major communicative skills (speaking, listening, reading, and writing). Students will learn to use simple to moderately complex sentences for communicating in different contextual settings, holding basic conversations, writing short descriptive passages, forming basic dialogues, and comprehending short texts.

CHAG1001 Chaghatay Language (3 credits/5 ECTS)

Instructor: TBA in late 2025

The course includes a survey of Chaghatay literature as well as a discussion of grammar, the writing system, and lexicographical resources; the class meetings will be devoted to both textbook-based instruction and (particularly in the second half of the course) the reading of samples from Chaghatay texts drawn from printed sources and manuscript copies.

UYGH1001 Uyghur Language (3 credits/5 ECTS)

Instructor: TBA in late 2025

The course emphasizes all four major communicative skills (speaking, listening, reading, and writing). Students are also introduced to Uyghur culture, history, and religion through readings, screenings, and class discussions. Another aim of the course is to expose students to a variety of topics in Uyghur culture through culture-based language activities so that students not only learn the Uyghur language, but also the culture, history, religion, and sociopolitical backgrounds of its speakers.

CHN1301 Beginning Chinese (3 credits, 5 ECTS)

Instructor: TBA in late 2025

This course introduces the basic elements of the Chinese language to enable students to engage in simple communication and provides a solid foundation for further study. Practice is given in the four skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Students will learn basic vocabulary and elementary grammatical structures, practice writing short compositions and dictations, delivering monologues, and reading graded materials. Speaking and listening skills will be developed primarily through self-study assignments.

RUS1301 Beginning Russian (3 credits, 5 ECTS)

Instructor: TBA in late 2025

This Beginning Russian course introduces the basic elements of the Russian language to enable students to engage in simple communication and provides a good foundation for further study. Practice is given in the four skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The course focuses on learning basic vocabulary and elementary grammatical structures, as well as writing short compositions and dictations.
