ERASMUS MUNDUS JOINT MASTER'S DEGREE

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters are prestigious international masters, jointly designed and delivered by at least 3 institutions from 3 different countries, alongside additional associated partners from the academic and non-academic world.

They typically include periods of study, research, traineeship, and thesis preparation, and give you the chance to study at multiple universities, as well as the chance to take language courses.

You will receive either a joint degree or multiple degrees upon completion, in addition to the time you'll have had to get to know the people, culture, landscapes, and history of the places where you studied.

The CEERES International Master programme delves into the political and societal dynamics of Central and Eastern Europe, the Baltics, the Balkans and Southeast Europe, the Caucasus, Central Asia, and broader Eurasia, including Russia.

While examining both the socialist and post-communist experiences of these regions and countries, we also explore long-term local developments and broader transnational trends across the area and beyond. This space is, regrettably, conflict-ridden, but also remarkably diverse, offering a rich tapestry of study opportunities for our students.

The **2-year programme** allows you to develop expertise on a particular region, including regional language training and specific study pathway themes. You may explore the following themes in more detail: Politics and Regional Integration Processes; International Development; EU Studies; Security and International Relations; History; and Societal Developments and Culture.

Our curriculum and mobility pathways aim to equip students with a toolbox of fresh and innovative theoretical and analytical approaches to study CEERE countries and regions, by integrating the expertise of our partner universities and deploying multidisciplinary methodological approaches and techniques. We also assist students in carrying out independent, specialised research projects and in developing employable and transferable skills to help them plan for their future careers.

CAREER PROSPECTS

You will be prepared for careers in policy-making in government, foreign ministries, the EU, intergovernmental organisations and non-governmental organisations. Other career opportunities include higher education, journalism, and business.
